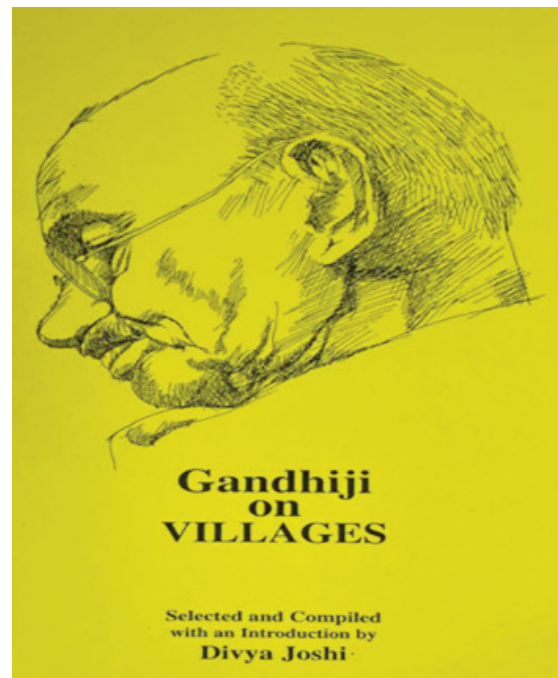

## Jamiat Youth Club It's historic step to adopt villages for holistic development

**T**he great Indian philosopher and freedom fighter icon, Mahatma Gandhi once said that the future of India lies in villages. He always stressed on development of villages. In a letter to his colleague, Jawahar Lal Nehru, he stressed that "My ideal village still exists only in my imagination. After all, every human being lives in the world of his imagination. In this village of my dreams, the villager will not be dull- he will be all awareness. He will not live like an animal in filth and darkness. Men and women will live in freedom, prepared to face the whole world. There will be no plague, no cholera and no smallpox. Nobody will be allowed to be idle or



to wallow in luxury. Everyone will

have to do body labour. Granting all this, I can still envisage a number of things that will have to be organized on a large scale. Perhaps there will even be railways and also post and telegraph offices. I do not know what things there will be or will not be. Nor am I bothered about it. If I can make sure of the essential thing, other things will follow in due course. But if I give up the essential thing, I give up everything."

The Jamiat Youth Club- wing of Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind has taken a stride in the development of villages with an idea of holistic village development based on multi-dimensional aspects including water, agriculture, gender, health, sanitization, drinking water and livelihood related issues.

It is great that that main focus will be on education including 100 enrolments of children ( 06-14) and on woman empowerment. Woman empowerment includes the formation of self-help groups, primary and reproductive health services and vocational skill development programs. Currently, 12 from UP, Haryana, Delhi and Bihar have been adopted and work has started there on the module.

The president of Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind Hazrat Maulana Mahmood Madani sb has urged the workers of the model village to work sustainably on the project and try to reach out to every villager. He also decided to bring moral and religious education to the adopted village

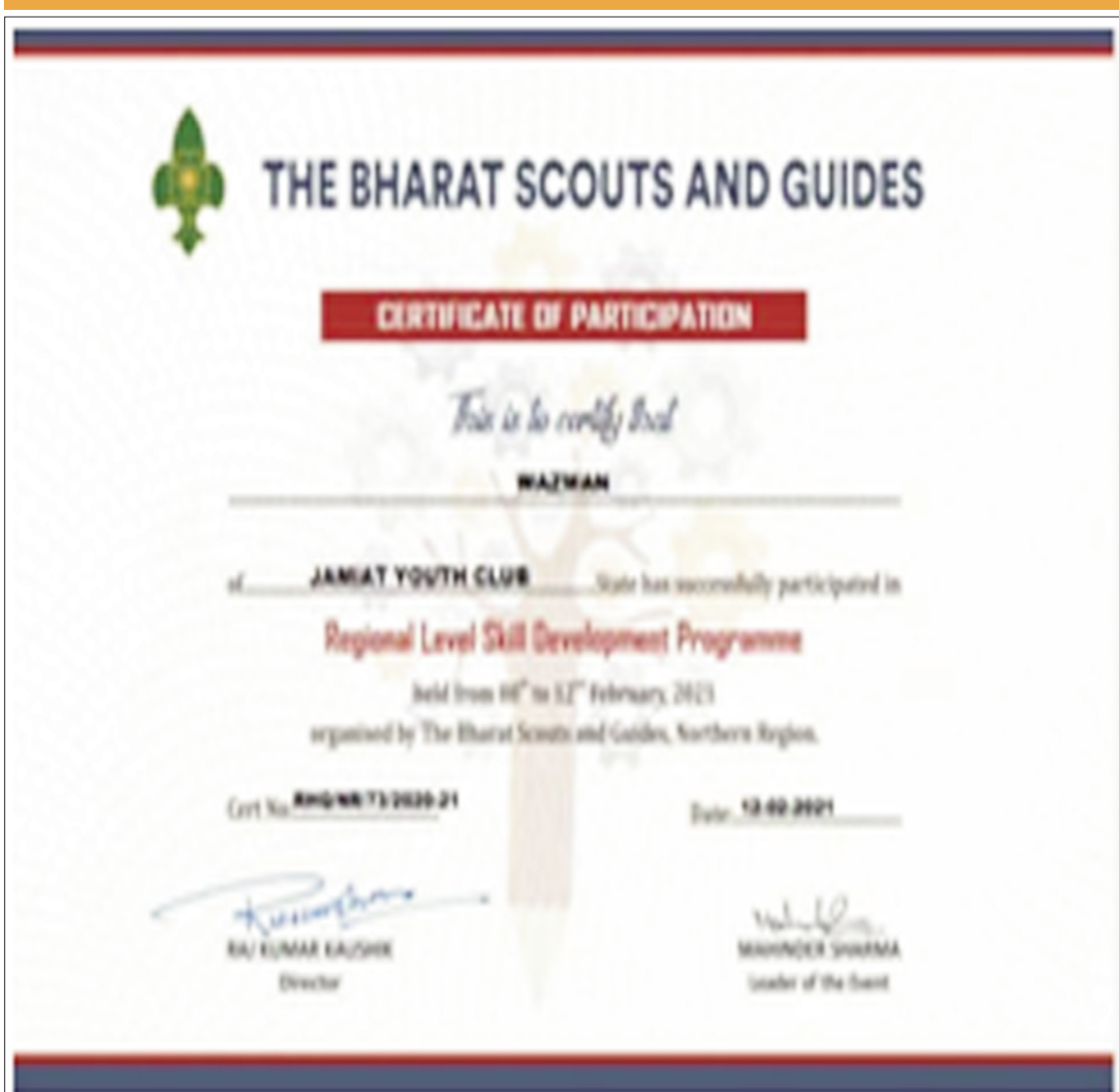


On March 30, 2021, members of JYC installed a water filter plant at Bhatgaon, Kishanganj, Bihar.
