



Role and Responsibility OF THE SELECTED MADARSAS

1. Every selected Madrasa will provide a class **room with the capacity of 30-40** students for **1-2 hours daily.**

2. The head of the Madrasa and Madrasa coordinators will **help identify students** for the course.

3. They will **monitor the progress** of the students especially their performance in their regular Madrasa curriculum.

- 4. They will provide required assistance to the district coordinator appointed
- by the Jamiat Open School.
