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What is Jamiat Study Centre

The Jamiat Study Centre is an educational project of Jamiat Ulama-i-Hind set up with a vision to train and give secular education to the Madarsa students, Madarsa graduates or drop out of the formal education stream. It enables the candidates to acquire basic qualification i.e. recognized secondary level opening the way for further higher education or to perform their role as religious leaders more effectively as well-informed citizens.

Why Do We Need

Almost all sections of society concur upon the urgent need of equipping Madrasa students with basic school education.

- 10th certificate might become a compulsory ID proof for everyone in future.
- Compulsory certificate for higher education as well as must document for passport.
- Presently, mandatory document in some organizations for identity proof.
- To apply for any govt. job, it is mandatory to pursue 10th, even for postman job.

Hurdle


In the Private Madrasa system any attempt to change the syllabi, curriculum or Govt. interference in the name of so-called modernization is apprehended to downgrade their religious educational standard or cause digression in their focus of attention and disturb their moral upbringing.

The apprehension is not totally baseless when compared with the situation of Govt. aided Madrasas.

Solution

There is a system whereby we may equip Madrasa students with certified and recognized secondary & sr. secondary level education without any adverse change in the existing Madrasa system namely:

- Syllabus & Curriculum.
- Financial Resources.
- Teachers and Existing staff.
- Organizational Structure, Administration.
- Focus or attention upon the main objective.



Jamiat Study Centre (JSC) - National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS)

Jamiat Study Centre prepares students to acquire secondary education through National Institute of Open Schooling. The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) is an educational organization which imparts education through open and distance learning mode and also conducts examinations for grant of certificates up to pre-degree level par with national board viz. the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and Council of Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE).

Freedom To Learn & Course Highlights

- The most suitable option for Madarsa students is to appear in the secondary level course.
- The NIOS provides flexibility with respect to the choice of subject, medium, admission process, and examination schedule
- The public exams are held twice a year in April-May and October-November.
- Nine examination chances are offered to the learner in five years.
- For obtaining a secondary certificate, a learner has to pass a minimum of five subjects of his choice.
- The secondary certificates obtained from NIOS have the same recognition as those of other boards.

Eligibility Criteria

- Minimum 14 years of age (Valid age Proof), as on 31st July of the year of admission.
- Certificate of 8th passed or self-attested affidavit.
- Aadhaar card or Ration card (any address proof) original scanned copy.

Subjects Recommended For Madarsa Students

English	Urdu/Hindi
Psychology	Business Studies
Social Science	History
Intro. to Law	Computer

Subjects like **Mathematics**, **Science** or **Commerce** etc. can be taken but not compulsory for qualifying secondary & sr. secondary certificate.

How The Target Is Proposed To Be Achieved

For districts, Jamiat Study Centre has appointed a district coordinator who in co-ordination with the management of the ten Madrasas of his district shall perform following functions:

- Selection of suitable students and helping them to register for admission in NIOS.
- Selection of Madarsa teachers and their training needs.
- Supervision of classes every day for 1-2 hours by Madarsa coordinator and virtual classes.
- Coordination with the study center of NIOS.
- Provision of study materials to the students.
- Weekly report to the project in-charge as per the recommended format.
- Coordination with the exam center of NIOS.

- Respective state president of Jamiat Ulama.
- Respective state Gen. secretary of Jamiat Ulama.
- President of Jamiat Ulama District Unit.
- Gen. secretary of Jamiat Ulama District Unit.
- Madarsa Coordinator designated by the Madarsa head
- District Coordinator appointed by Jamiat Study Centre.

50 thousand students from 90 districts and 900 madarasas will be enrolled in five years under the programme as per the following schedule:

Human Resources

Success of our plan largely depends upon the district coordinators and on Madarsa coordinators who will be responsible for execution of the plan in the 10 madarasas of selected district covering 200 students in a year. Each district will require 10 Madarsa coordinators.

Project Implementation Resource

For districts, a district coordinator in co-ordination with district academic council shall execute to achieve the target in allotted 10 Madarasas of his district.

Students Selection Process

Madarsa students or drop out of the formal stream are selected on the basis of entrance test conducted by the Jamiat Education Foundation (JEF).

Role and Responsibility of The Selected Madarsas

- Every selected Madarsa will provide a class room with the capacity of 20-30 students for 1-2 hours.
- The head of the Madarsa and Madarsa coordinator will help identify students for the course.
- They will monitor the progress of the students especially their performance in their regular madrasa curriculum.
- They will provide required assistance to the district coordinator appointed by the Jamiat.
