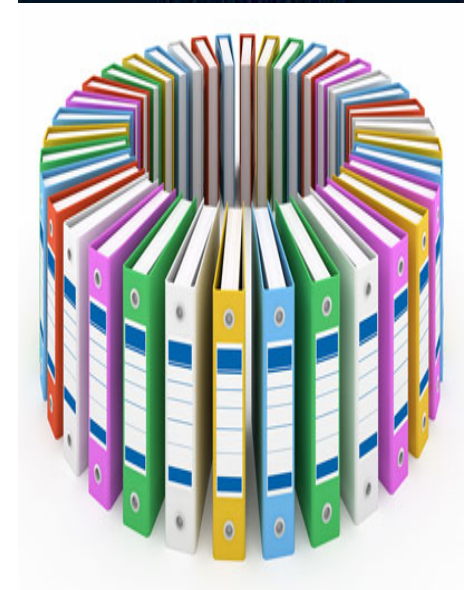

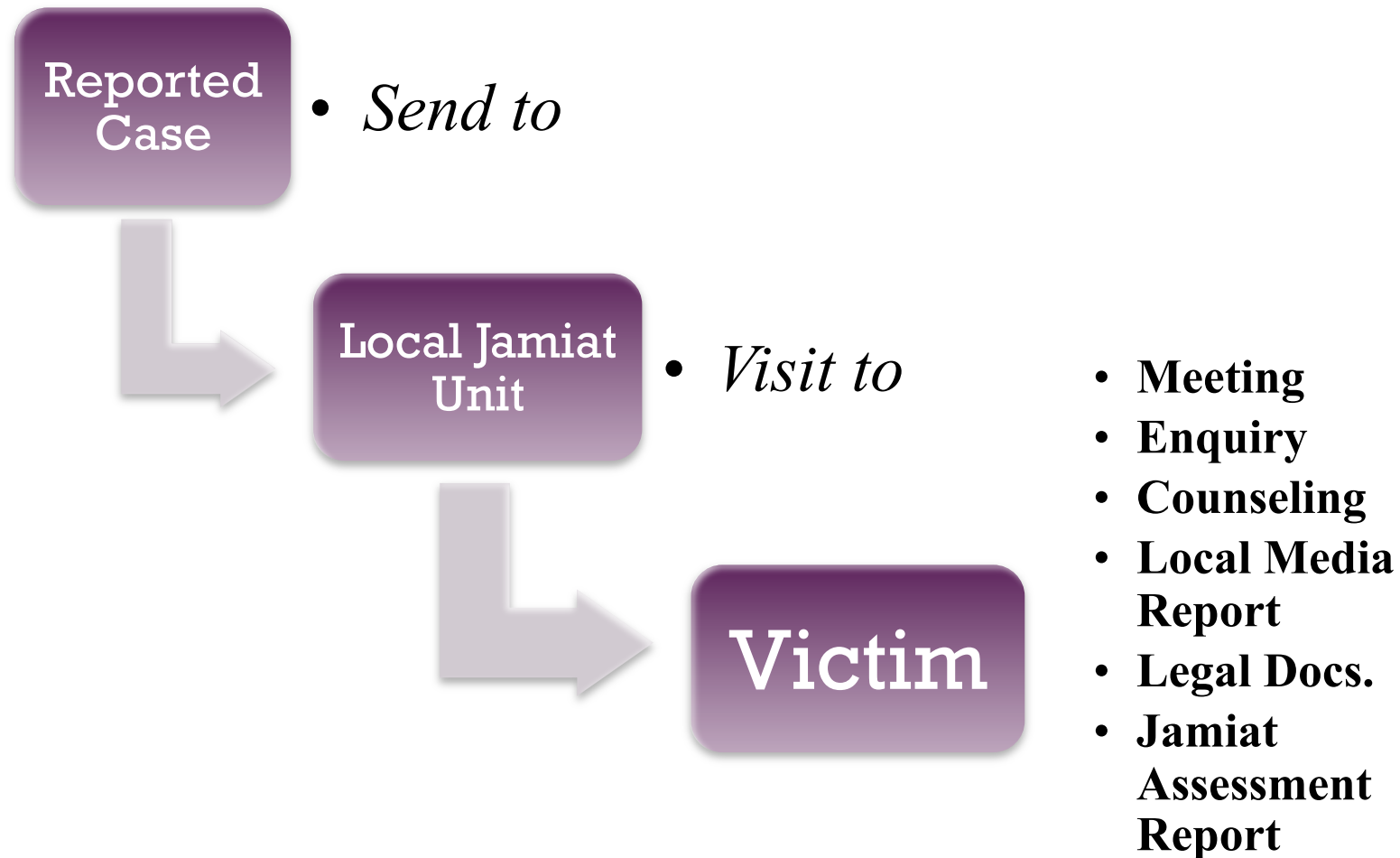

Subject: Religious Sentiments of Muslims deeply hurt by inflammatory and communal divisive statements given by Dinesh Bhatti, Kulbhushan Bardwai & Mahaveer Bardwai

Respected Sir,

On various occasions, we have observed that a certain group of persons, in particular Dinesh Bhatti, Kulbhushan Bardwai & Mahaveer Bardwai, have been repeatedly making provocative statements in public with the intention of promoting enmity against Islam which have deeply hurt the religious sentiments of the Muslim community. Needless to say they are repeatedly doing these acts that are prejudicial to the maintenance of communal harmony

A YouTube video published by the News Media House 'The Wire' has gone viral on Internet wherein Dinesh Bhatti can be evidently seen making fun of the Muslim community by saying that 'We Hindus know where our deities were born; but no one knows where Allah was born, whom 'Muslims believe as their God'. He further declares that 'wherever Muslims go to offer their obligatory Juma Namaz, we will go there with a sword'. Said statement is a deliberate and malicious act intended specifically to outrage religious sentiments of the Muslim community by insulting their religion and religious beliefs.

Similarly, a video of Kulbhushan Bardwai) has also surfaced online where he is suggesting that Muslims are not finding a place to pray in Gurugram because they are giving birth to more children. He has gone on to assert that they (Muslims) should stop producing children as they don't have enough places in Gurugram to pray. It is submitted that this statement and its propagation on social media is prejudicial to maintenance of communal harmony and intended at hurting the religious sentiments of the Muslim Community.

A video of Mahaveer Bardwai) has also surfaced, wherein he mocks the Muslim Community by asking, "During Covid-19 pandemic, the Muslims did not come out to pray for their Juma Namaz. Was Allah angry with Muslims or did HE go away somewhere on Holiday?" This remark as well as other remarks are in a series of malicious attempts to create communal disharmony and hurt religious sentiments.

Therefore, we request you to take appropriate action in accordance with law immediately against the offending 3 persons and all other persons involved in this conspiracy, who have deeply hurt the Muslim Community and are desirously making such statements in an attempt to maliciously spread disharmony in the society.

We are attaching the videos of the above mentioned incidents along with this letter.

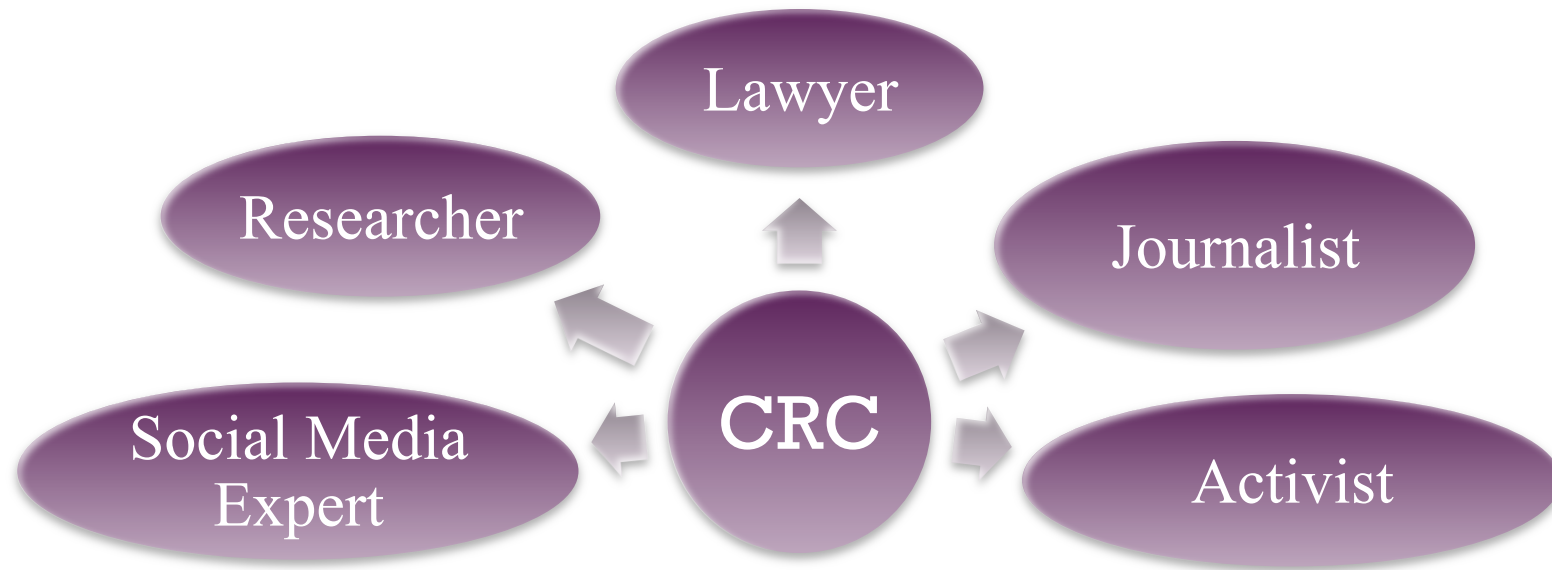

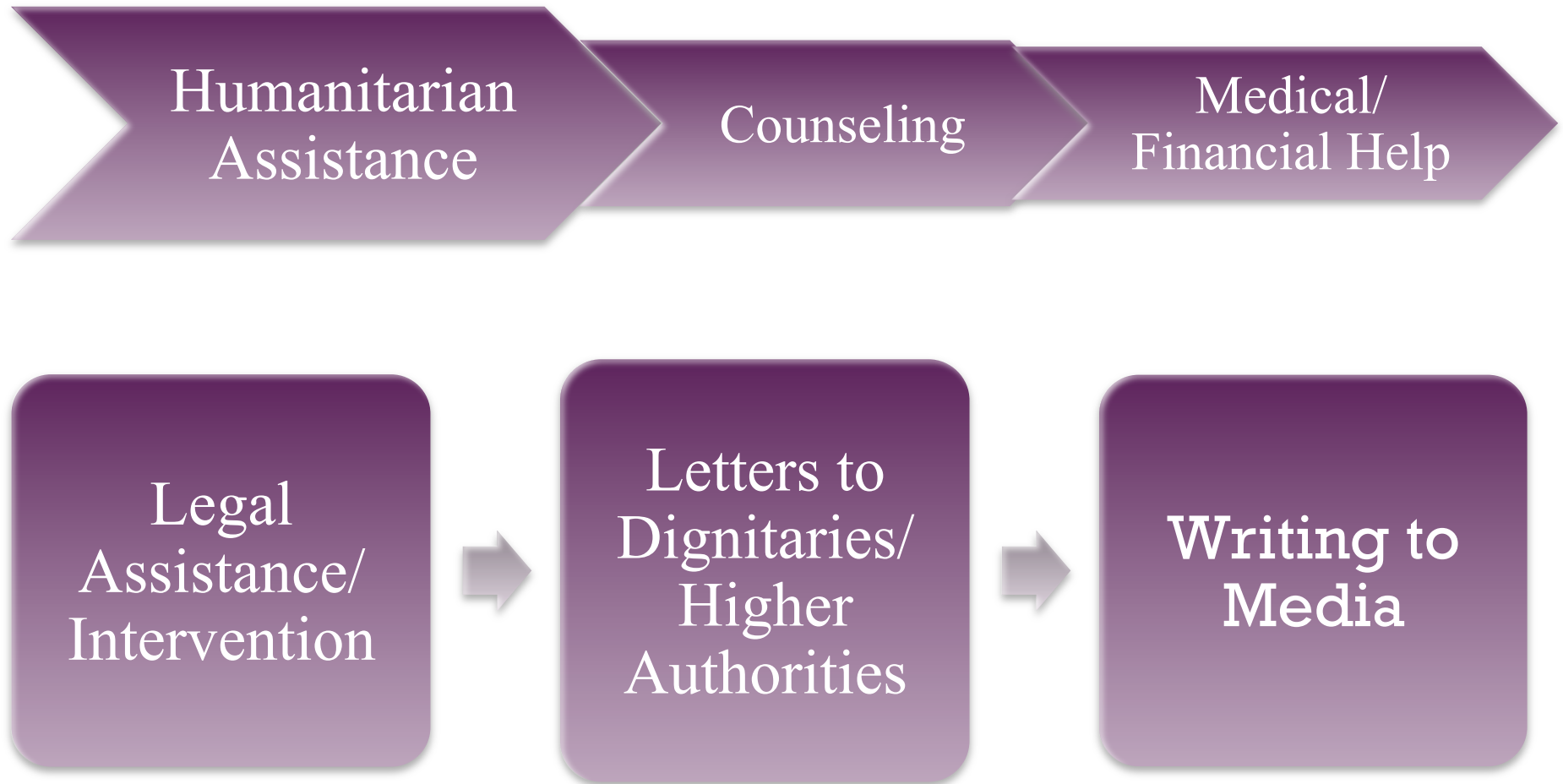

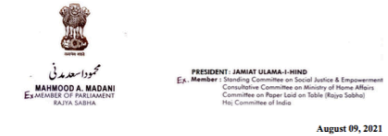

There in the event leaders at the programme raised highly objectionable and inflammatory speech and slogans, "**Jab Mulla (Muslims) Kate Jayenge, Ram-Ram Chhlayenge**" (When Muslim would be massacred, they will cry Ram Ram), against Muslims. They called for massacring Muslim in India. The video of the alleged programme is being circulated and shared by large number of people on social media platforms. It has created a fear psychosis among the Muslims and peace loving people across all communities. We suppose that Delhi police must have taken notice of the event.

I would like to recall the statement of the newly appointed commissioner of Police, Delhi, Shri Rakesh Asthana Ji, who has affirmed that communal harmony and fairness will be his top priority being Delhi Police Commissioner. In this view and the keeping seriousness of the event organized at Jantar Mantar, I would like to request you to kindly instruct concerned officers at Ministry of Home Affairs and Delhi Police to take stern actions against the culprits who had organized that event and gave call for massacring Muslims and an FIR be lodged against them. I am apprehensive about the situation being developed in Delhi, law and order of Delhi is being put on the risk by extremist groups once again and situation like Delhi Riots 2020 may recur if such people are not apprehended in time and the programme like this is not stopped prior to their occurrence.

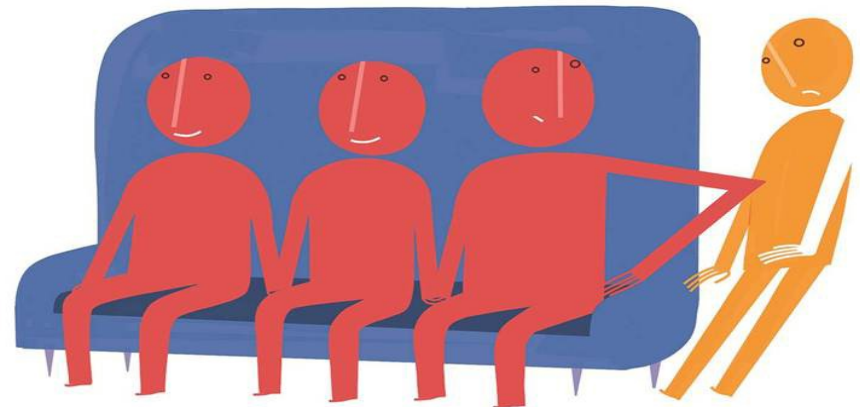

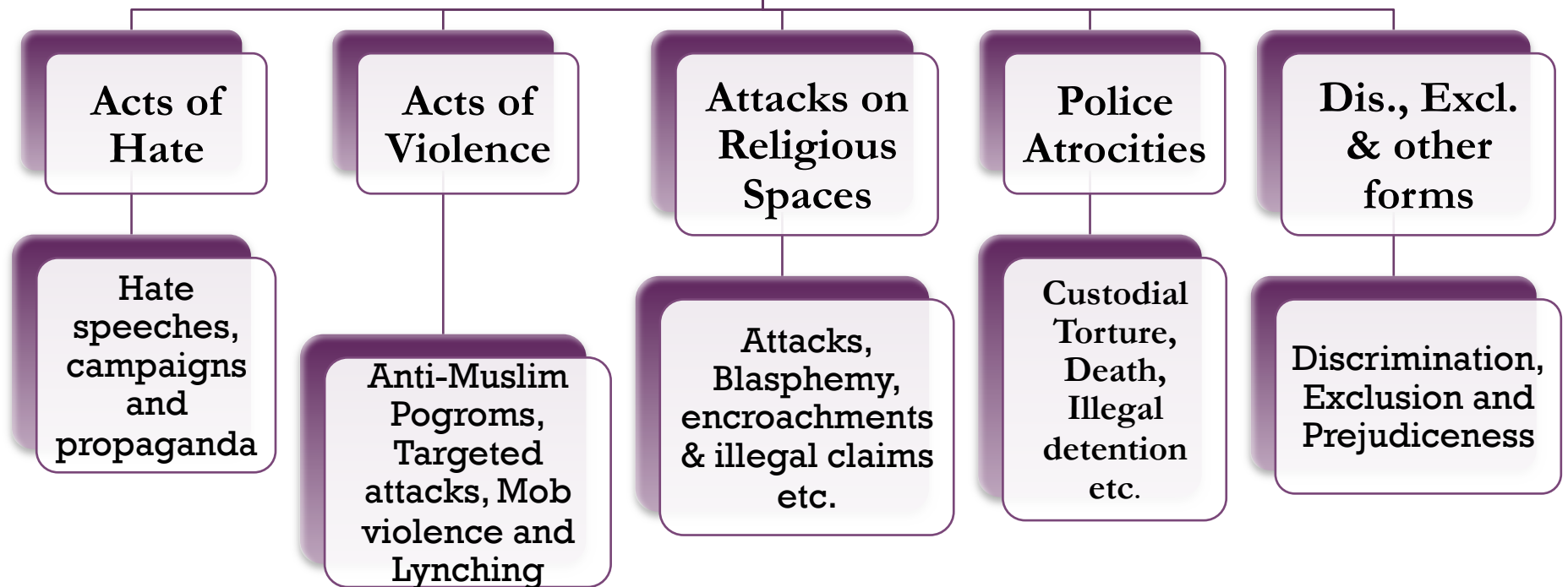

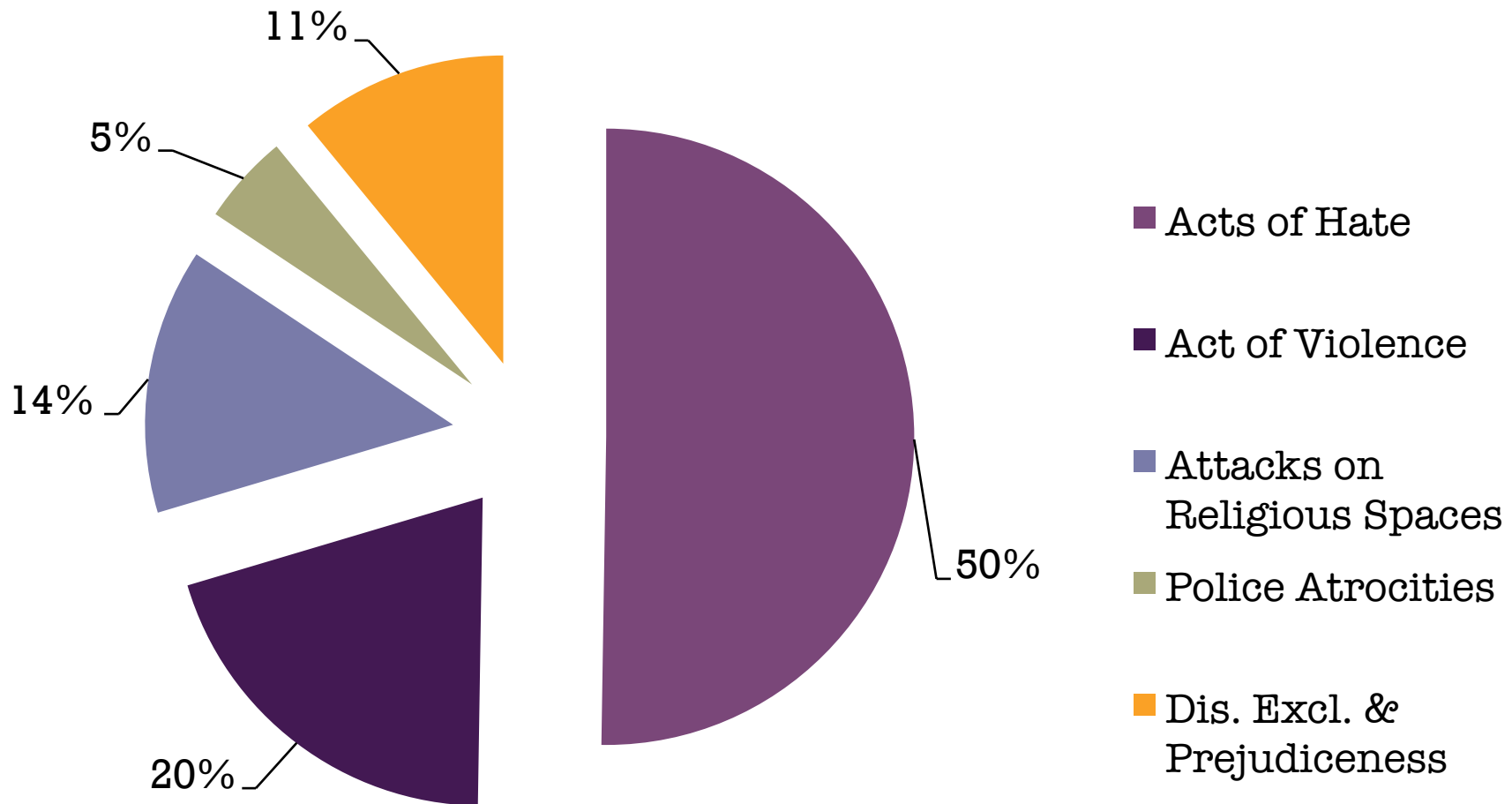

Islamophobia Pie Chart: July 2021-June 2022

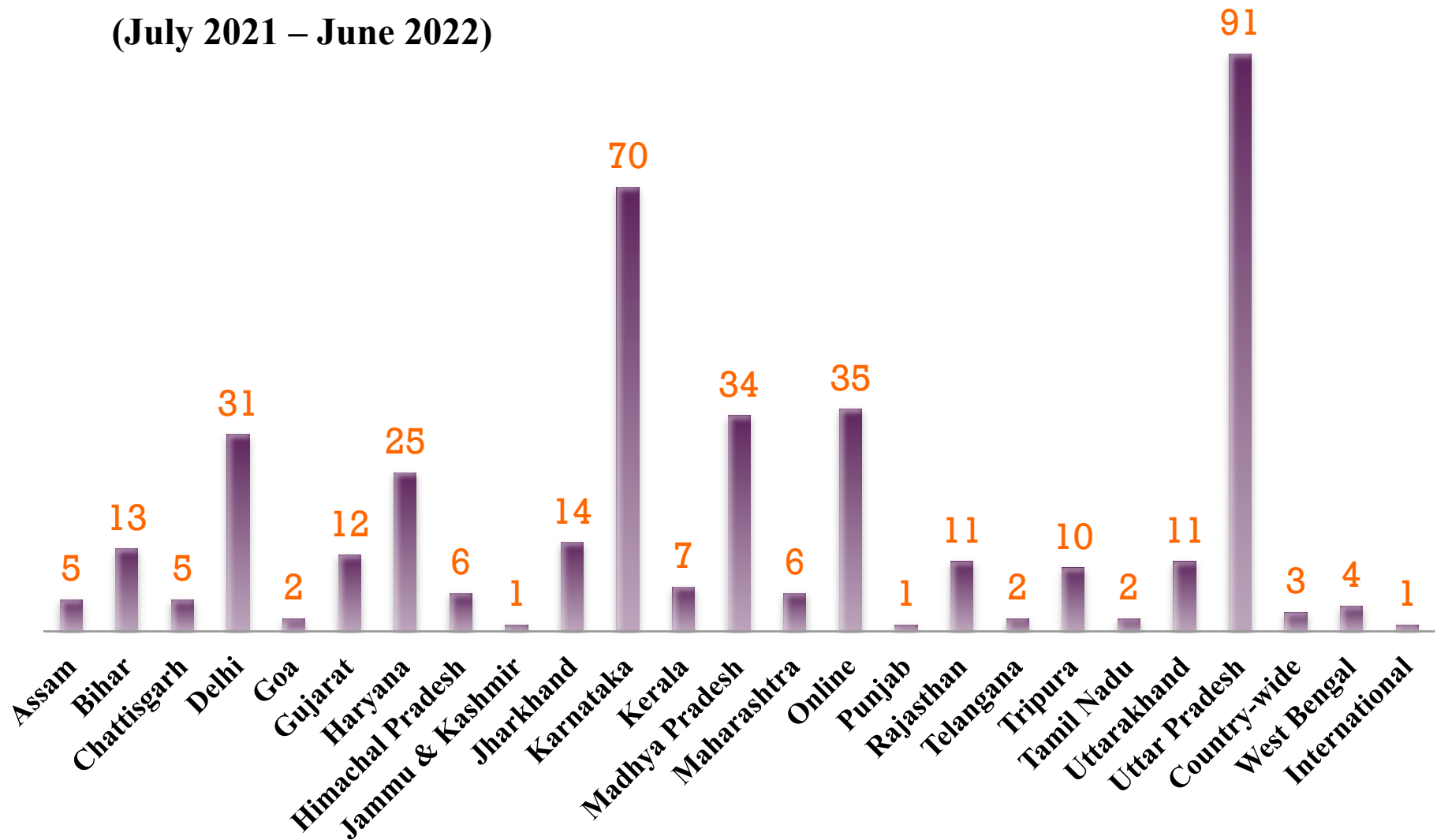

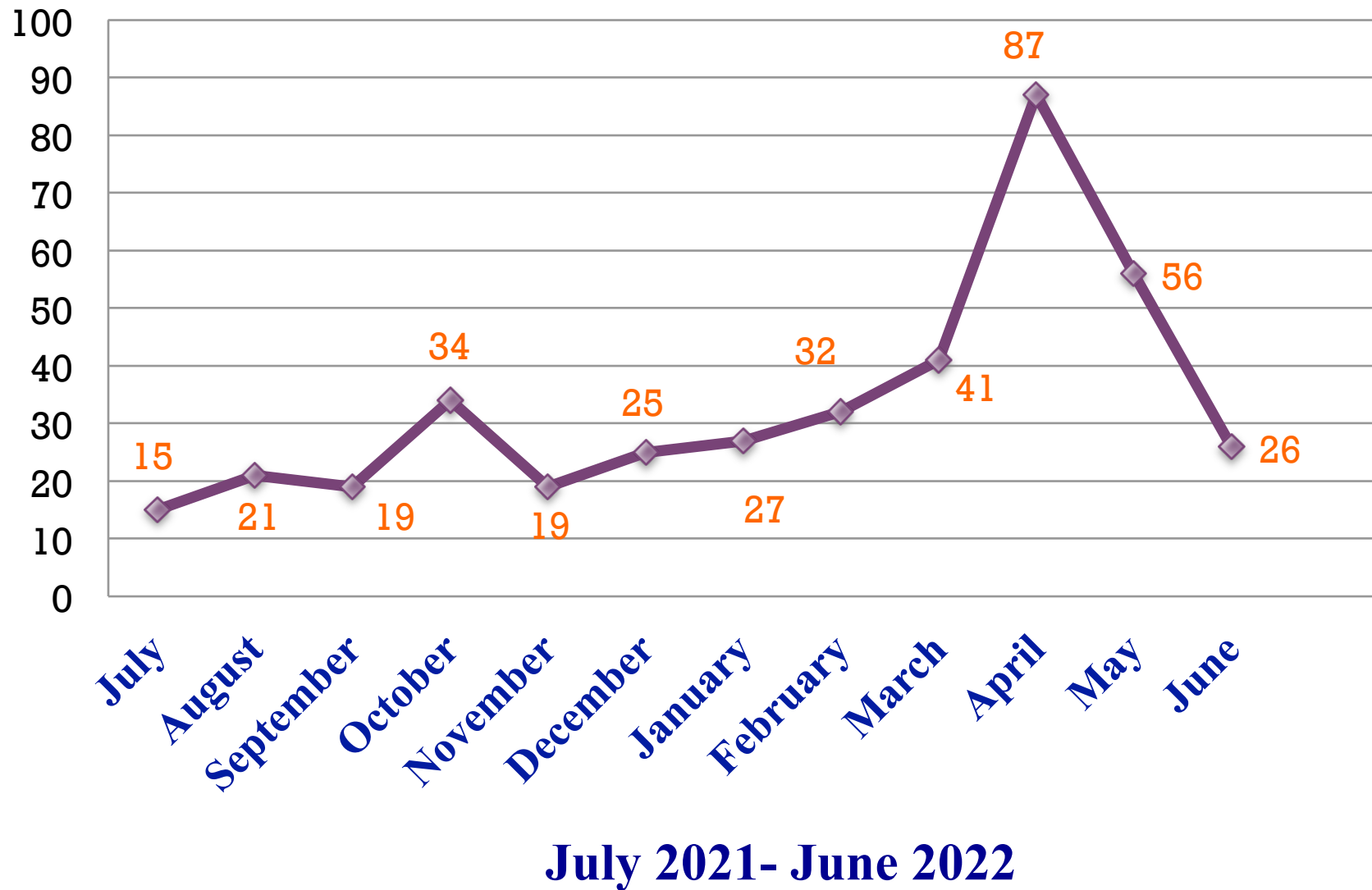
Cases of hate and Islamophobia State-wise
